Practical Information

Dates: This retreat will take place on Thursday and Friday. You will attend with your Sophomore Religious Studies class.

Please note: This is not an overnight retreat.

Students will return home on Thursday night

Times: Thursday, October 23rd

- **8:00 am** – Meet at the flagpole in front of school
- **8:15 am** – Bus departs for St Anthony's (121 Golden Gate Ave, SF, CA 94102)
- **6:00 pm** – Students arrive back at SI
- **6:30 pm** – **Parents arrive at SI – Meet in the Commons**
- **8:00 pm** – Closing prayer and retreat ends for the night

Friday, October 24th

- **8:00** – Students arrive and check in for FML
- **2:00** – Retreat ends

Transportation:

- Students will travel via school bus – no private cars

Classes:

You are excused from classes during the retreat without penalty. Please complete any major assignments before the retreat, and check with your teachers **PRIOR TO RETREAT** for any arrangements for missed work or make-up tests. Students are expected to take exams and quizzes scheduled for the day after retreat unless they make other arrangements with the teacher.

Meals:

- Lunch and dinner will be provided on Thursday
- **Please bring a bag lunch for Friday.**

What to wear:

- Casual clothes – jeans are allowed. Students should wear layers as we will be outside and inside throughout the day. Please make sure clothing is modest (no tank tops, arms and neckline should be covered).
- **CLOSED TOE SHOES ARE REQUIRED**
- No logos, brand names on clothing, sunglasses or hats

Please do NOT bring:

- Backpacks/school books
- iPods and cell phones

- Any sophomore who is unable to join in the spirit of the retreat or is unable to cooperate with St. Anthony Foundation Rules will be sent home and be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.
