Who can apply?

- Students who would benefit from a structured environment, extended school day (7:30am–5:00pm), and year-round program (August–July).
- Families who qualify for financial assistance.
- Families who will commit to supporting their child's academic success. That support includes attending school functions, participating in monthly community meetings, adhering to the demands of the academic calendar of classes and activities, limiting use of television at home, nightly reading, and reviewing nightly homework.

The Fr. Sauer Academy is a 6th–8th grade middle school that is part of St. Ignatius College Preparatory. We offer a private, Catholic, Jesuit education to boys and girls who have great promise and financial limitations.

In the Jesuit tradition, the Academy is concerned with development of the whole person. We aim to meet all needs and to provide opportunities for academic, social and spiritual growth.
