### IMPORTANT DEADLINES

Friday September 2	Election Materials Available in the Student Affairs Office
Friday September 23	All Election Materials due by 8:30 AM Including Faculty Endorsements to the Student Affairs Office.
Monday September 26	Posters may be placed in the hallways or Student Center. No posters are allowed in the stairwells. Inappropriate posters will be taken down and candidate may be asked to withdraw from the race. (Posters must be taken down by 8:15am September 23 <sup>rd</sup> except those continuing on in the election)
Tuesday September 27 - Thursday September 29	Primary Election held online. Students may vote for two candidates. Top five will serve as the class officers. NO candidate will be allowed to campaign within 100 feet of any computer. No email campaigning is allowed. No Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter or any other online communication program posts of any kind are allowed. If this occurs the candidate will be dismissed from the election. No passing out gifts such as candy, buttons, etc.
Thursday September 29	Meeting for all candidates in room 430 immediately afterschool. Top five officers who would like to run for President will speak at an assembly.
Tuesday October 4	Frosh President Election Assembly during X Period in Cowell Gym. Officers running for president will present their speeches.
Tuesday October 4 - Wednesday October 5	Frosh President Election begins online after assembly. Students may vote for one candidate. All campaign rules stated above are in effect
Wednesday October 5	Frosh Officers meeting in room 430 immediately after school.
