



I have prepared a **Summer French Scavenger Hunt** that I hope you will find useful, interesting, varied and fun. Each task has a corresponding point value. Make sure that the tasks you choose to complete add up to 100 points. **Check off the tasks you complete.**

- **20 Points:** Choose an authentic French movie (rated appropriately voir liste). Watch it in French. Then write a half- page summary of the movie in French. Include your opinion about the movie as well.

- **20 Points:** Write an essay of at least 25 sentences double spaced on the topic below. Print it out and bring it to class:

*Liberté, égalité et fraternité; c'est la devise de la France!
D'après vous, que veut dire le mot "liberté"?
Est-ce qu'il y a des gens qui sont vraiment libres ?
D'après vous, que veut dire le mot "égalité"?
Est-ce que l'égalité existe soit ici ou soit en France ? Comment ?*

- **10 Points:** Bring in a menu all in French (no English)! Translate all food items into English.
- **10 Points:** Find a French/Belgian comic strip (Bande Dessinée) and translate the story. Print it out and bring it to class.
- **10 Points:** *Mes nouvelles chansons préférées en français, sont (5 chansons)*
Dis-moi pourquoi tu aimes ces chansons.
ex : J'aime beaucoup le rythme, les paroles (=lyrics), la mélodie, la voix du chanteur/de la chanteuse, le message de la chanson,...
- **20 points: Practice reading, listening, and speaking by visiting:**

Go to the "Advanced Readings" section and choose one of the stories by Guy de Maupassant.
Each story is accompanied by an audio file.
 1. Read the story.
 2. Listen to the audio file.
 3. Summarize the story (20 lines double spaced)
- **5 Points:** Follow <https://www.instagram.com/frenchwords/?hl=en>
Make a list of 15 vocabulary words and translate them to English. Be prepared to teach them to the class.

- **5 Points:** Listen to a French radio commercial/jingle. Learn and recite it for the class. Let us know what product is being sold. Print it out and bring it to class.
- **10 Points:** Learn and recite a poem by a famous French poet (ex. Guillaume Apollinaire, Jean Cocteau, Jean de La Fontaine, Victor Hugo, Jacques Prévert). Print and translate the poem you choose and bring it to class.
- **25 Points:** Write me an e-mail svilna@siprep.org in the month of July. Send me an email that reports what you have done so far this summer (past tense with *passé composé* and *imparfait*) and what you will do (future) for the rest of the summer. (50 words)
