

## SUMMER ASSIGNMENT FOR MANDARIN 3/ 3H

### CHINESE JOURNAL 中文日记

#### STANDARD:

1. Choose any **SEVEN** days during summer to write a journal in **CHINESE CHARACTERS**. You can hand-write or type and print out the content.
2. Your journal should be in **printed** form and one page for each day. You may draw pictures or add photos, etc. for each day.

**NOTE:** The online translation tools are only for finding words. You should use various sentence patterns we have covered in the past years to write your journal. You should prepare to share/read your journal in groups when the school starts.

3. There should be a **COVER** with your Chinese name, class name (中文三 or 中文三 H), and journal title (二 XXX 年暑假). (暑假: shǔjià; summer vacation)

4. Minimum word count requirements for each day:

Mandarin 3—60 characters, including punctuations

Mandarin 3H—100 characters, including punctuations

5. Due on the first FULL class meeting in August (not the first Friday).
