"Using a print textbook helps me stay focused while I read."

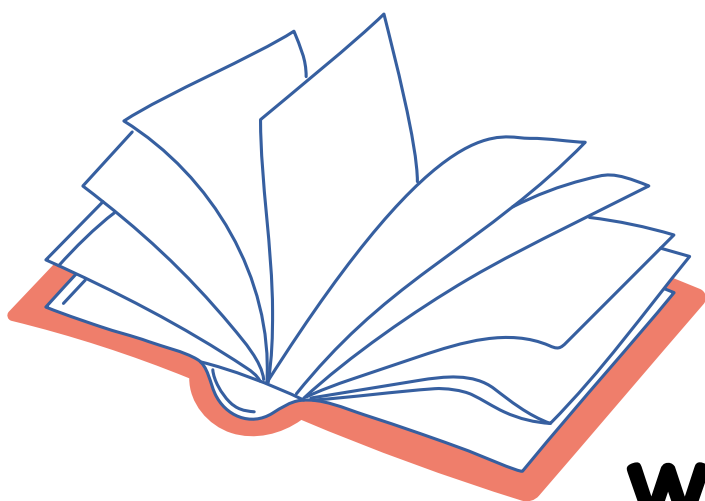
PROS

- Research shows students comprehend and retain more when reading print text than when reading digital text.
- Reading print text does not add to daily screen time.

CONS

- More expensive.
- Heavy, 5lbs 4.5oz, but students can place them in their lockers when not in use.

PROS

- Less expensive.
- Weightless and students will always have it with them on their iPad.

CONS

- Students comprehend and retain less information when reading digital text than when reading print text.
- Reading digital text adds to daily screen time.
