ASSISTANT GIRLS' CREW COACH

St. Ignatius College Prep in San Francisco is looking to hire Girls' Assistant Varsity Coaches to work with its varsity squad for the 2019 Spring Season.

TIME COMMITMENT: 5-6 days/week would be ideal for the role, but fewer days can be managed if necessary. Practices are 3:30pm - 5:30PM, Monday - Friday, and Saturday mornings, + regattas. HOWEVER, we can also adjust practice times depending on your work schedule (for example, early morning workouts during the week are certainly part of the 3V/4V culture).

SEASON: Mid-January through mid/late May

PAY: St. Ignatius pays its coaches an hourly wage.

The ideal candidate is a positive person with a passion for rowing, an interest in developing and challenging younger athletes, and a creative mind. High school and /or collegiate rowing experience is ideal, and some coaching experience is a plus but not required.
