Due to the escalating severity of the COVID-19 outbreak within and beyond the United States, it is with our deepest regret to announce that we are cancelling the Latinx Youth Summit, originally scheduled for March 13-14, 2020. Our hope is to reschedule the Summit for September 2020, pending official travel and health recommendations.

Since the health, safety, and comfortability of our attendees, sponsors, and speakers are our utmost priority, we have been advised to avoid all non-essential travel. With approximately 300 attendees from across the United States, we believe cancelling the Summit is in the best interest of everyone involved.

We apologize for the late notice, especially to those who have already made travel and lodging arrangements. Registration fees will be reimbursed. Our understanding is that some airlines and hotels have implemented more lenient cancellation policies, so we encourage you to reach out to them as soon as possible.

We are sorry for the inconvenience this may have caused you, your students, and our communities. We will follow-up shortly regarding registration refunds. Please reach out if you have any questions.
