



# ST. IGNATIUS COLLEGE PREPARATORY SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT

Providing access to a Jesuit education to families across the economic spectrum has been a core mission of Jesuit schools worldwide since Ignatius of Loyola opened the first school in Messina, Italy, in 1548.

A strong Scholarship Endowment is vital to the future financial health of St. Ignatius College Preparatory, as it provides a perpetual stream of revenue for tuition assistance. In the 2019-2020 school year, the Scholarship Endowment will provide \$3.5 million of the \$5.2 million needed in financial assistance to 24% of the student body. The average student's assistance is \$13,500.

In October 2015, St. Ignatius announced the launch of the Scholarship Endowment portion of the Compass Campaign. The goal is to increase St. Ignatius' Scholarship Endowment Fund to \$100 million.
