Criteria for Grant

Summer Grant will be offered to groups of teachers whose work will focus on E3 EIP goals: Metrics to Measure Excellence, Engagement of All, and Student Centered Learning.

Stipends and Expenses:

Grants will consist of a stipend for teacher's time as well as monies for expenses related to the project.

Application Process

Applications are due by **Friday, May 1**.

To apply, open the Summer Grant Application form, rename it with your department name and the contact person for the proposal (ex: Math Shapiro), and **share the newly renamed document with Janet Shapiro**. Complete your application **by Friday, May 1**

Applications will be reviewed by a committee including your department chairperson and will be acted on no later than **May 27, 2015**.

By **Friday, August 21, 2014**, grant recipients must evaluate their summer project (on the original application), submit receipts for reimbursement of materials, and share any written or published curriculum, projects or activities with Janet Shapiro and your department chairperson.

By **Friday, September 18**, each group must share a brief summary of their work on Schoology (Faculty and Staff group).
